



Tumbleweed Smith

Texas native Tumbleweed Smith started his daily radio program, *The Sound of Texas*, in 1969. It went on to become the most widely syndicated feature program in Texas. In the show's 40-plus years, he has developed the largest independent collection of oral history in the United States with a library of more than 10,000 interviews. By 1986 Smith's passion for bringing Texas characters to life over the airways expanded into a syndicated weekly newspaper column.

Tumbleweed has a love and appreciation for Texas and Texans. He shares his passion and entertains through speaking engagements, his three stage plays: *Texas Stories*, *Mountain Voices*, and *Natural Born Storytellers*. He is the author of two books and 15 audiocassettes and CDs on Texas humor and insight and has performed live all over Texas and in six other states and three foreign countries.

Smith owns an internationally recognized advertising and production company. His honors include two CLIO advertising awards, the governor's award for tourism, the West Texas Chamber of Commerce Cultural Achievement Award, two Telly Statuettes, and two Freedoms Foundation Awards.
